Bill NO. SB 2673	Description RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION. Requires DLNR to ensure sufficient buffers for public historic and cultural properties. Specifies that acquisition of surrounding lands for buffers is a taking of private property for public use. Chair's Inclination – Pass As Is	Referral MAT/JHW, WAM
SB 2433	MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR CAREER CRIMINAL PROSECUTION UNITS AND VICTIM WITNESS ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS. Appropriates funds for a grant-in-aid to the Prosecuting Attorney's office of each county for the career prosecution units and the victim witness assistance programs. Chair's Inclination - To be announced at the hearing.	IGA/JHW, WAM
SB 2323	RELATING TO FEDERAL REVENUE MAXIMIZATION IN THE JUDICIARY. Requires the District and Family Courts to establish and implement a federal revenue maximization program for all services provided to children in their care that may be eligible for federal financial participation. Chair's Inclination – SDI Amended to include technical, non-substantive changes. Also to take into consideration changes recommended by the Department of Human Services.	HMS/JHW, WAM
SB 2334	MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION FOR THE HAWAII YOUTH CORRECTIONAL FACILITY. Emergency appropriation (\$1,320,000) to ensure that funding for the operations of the Hawaii Youth Correctional Facility (HYCF) is maintained through the end of FY 2005-2006. Chair's Inclination – SD1 Amended to include technical, non-substantive changes. Also to incorporate the Attorney General's comments to allow funding over the next two years.	HMS/JHW, WAM
SB 2141	RELATING TO SEX ASSAULT SERVICES. Appropriates moneys to fully fund sexual assault services in the State. Chair's Inclination – SD1 Amended to include \$1,076,200.	HTH/JHW, WAM

SB 2261	RELATING TO DISCLOSURE OF VITAL STATISTICS RECORDS TO LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS FOR CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIONS. Adds law enforcement officers to those who are considered to have a direct and tangible interest in public health statistic records. Chair's Inclination – Pass As Is	HTH/JHW
SB 2639	RELATING TO AUTOMATIC EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS. Requires certain places of employment, physical fitness facilities, and buildings, to be equipped with an automatic external defibrillator. Expands the "Good Samaritan" exemption from liability as it applies to users of automatic external defibrillators. Chair's Inclination – Hold There is a title problem. "automatic" should be "automated".	HTH/JHW, WAM
SB 2173	RELATING TO SERVICE LEARNING. Requires service-learning opportunities for all students in public schools. Requires service-learning projects as part of high school curriculum for graduation from public high schools. Exempts students engaged in service-learning projects from civil liability. Makes appropriation. Chair's Inclination – SD1 Amend to include \$1.5million.	EDM/JHW, WAM
SB 2147	RELATING TO HAWAIIAN EDUCATION. Establishes a noncontiguous Hawaiian charter school district under the board of education to be monitored by a Hawaiian charter school council. Chair's Inclination - Hold	EDM/JHW, WAM
SB 2905	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Provides island-wide bus service for the only DOE public Hawaiian immersion school on Kauai. Makes appropriation. Chair's Inclination – SD1 Amend to provide a maximum of \$75,000 for transportation and that it will be split equally between OHA and the DOE.	EDM/JHW, WAM
SB 3122	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Appropriates \$5,000 to each school that has a Hawaiian language immersion program for translation of books and materials into Hawaiian. Appropriates staff for the English for second language learners program. Chair's Inclination – SD1 Amend Part 1 to provide \$5,000 for each of seventeen schools. Delete Part 2.	EDM/JHW, WAM
