A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR CLAIMS AGAINST THE STATE, ITS OFFICERS, OR ITS EMPLOYEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	PART I
2	SECTION 1. In accordance with section 9 of Article VII, of
3	the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and sections 37-91 and
4	37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined
5	that the general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2006-
6	2007 (established at \$5,357,987,705 on November 8, 2006) has
7	already been exceeded by \$90,137,694 or 1.68 per cent. The
8	appropriations contained in this Act will cause the state
9	general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2006-2007 to be
10	exceeded by an additional \$1,351,843.07 or an additional .025
11	per cent. The calculation contained in the foregoing sentence
12	relates only to the amount of general funds appropriated in this
13	Act for fiscal year 2006-2007. The reasons for exceeding the
14	general fund expenditure ceiling are that the appropriations
15	made in this Act are necessary to serve the public interest and
16	to meet the needs provided for by this Act.

- 5 SECTION 7. If any provision of this Act, or the

- 7 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
- 8 applications of the Act, which can be given effect without the
- 9 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
- 10 of this Act are severable.
- 11 SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
