## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FEES FOR WINDSHIELD PLACARDS FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291-51.3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "[4] \$291-51.3[4] Reimbursement to counties. The State
- 4 shall reimburse the counties for the unit cost of issuing a
- 5 removable windshield placard or a temporary removable windshield
- 6 placard on behalf of the State. Beginning July 1, 2006, the
- 7 rate of the per unit cost reimbursement shall be \$12. All fees
- 8 collected by the counties for issuing removable and temporary
- 9 removable windshield placards shall be deposited into the state
- 10 general fund.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 291-51.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 "\$291-51.6 Issuance of temporary removable windshield
- 14 [parking] placards. Each county shall issue one temporary
- 15 removable windshield placard and a second temporary removable
- 16 windshield placard to each applicant who requests and presents a
- 17 certificate of disability that verifies the duration of the

1	applicant's disability in monthly increments, which shall not
2	exceed six months, and upon payment of a fee to the issuing
3	agency. All fees collected by the counties for issuing
4	temporary removable windshield placards shall be deposited into
5	the state general fund. The temporary removable windshield
6	placard shall be designed, fabricated, and sold to the counties
7	at a rate negotiated by the disability and communication access
8	board."
9	SECTION 3. Section 291-52.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10	amended to read as follows:
11	"§291-52.6 Replacement of a lost, stolen, or mutilated
12	removable windshield placard or identification card. A
13	removable windshield placard, temporary removable windshield
14	placard, or identification card that is reported lost, stolen,
15	or mutilated shall be replaced upon [the submittal of a]:
16	(1) Submittal to the issuing agency of:
17	(A) A written statement by a person with a disability
18	that the placard or identification card was
19	either lost, stolen, or mutilated [and a]; and
20	(B) A completed application for a removable
21	windshield placard, temporary removable

1	windshield placard, or identification card to the
2	issuing agency[+]; and
3	(2) Payment of a fee to the issuing agency.
4	All fees collected by the counties for replacement of a lost,
5	stolen, or mutilated removable windshield placard shall be
6	deposited into the state general fund."
7	SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
8	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
9	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon approval.
