

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Over the years, many young Americans have had
- 2 their education interrupted or curtailed due to compulsory
- 3 induction into the military during times of conflict or war.
- 4 Others have had their schooling interrupted due to wartime
- 5 practices, such as the internment of Japanese and Japanese-
- 6 Americans during World War II.
- 7 The purpose of this Act is to direct the department of
- 8 education to establish a program to grant veterans high school
- 9 diplomas to veterans of the armed services who could not
- 10 complete their high school education due to compulsory service
- 11 in the armed services of the United States during World War II,
- 12 the Korean conflict, or the Vietnam War, as well as those who
- 13 did not complete high school because of wartime practices.
- 14 SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 15 amended by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately
- 16 designated and to read as follows:
- 17 "§302A- Veterans high school diploma for armed services

- 5 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
