A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TICKET SALES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 481B, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a section to be appropriately designated and
- 3 to read as follows:
- 4 "§481B- Ticket brokers; fees; cancellation. (a) No
- 5 ticket broker shall charge a fee for the use of a credit card to
- 6 purchase tickets without first disclosing that a fee will be
- 7 charged.
- 8 (b) A ticket broker shall refund any and all service fees
- 9 charged for the purchase of a ticket when the public exhibition,
- 10 game, contest, or performance for which the ticket was purchased
- 11 is canceled.
- (c) For the purposes of this section, "ticket broker"
- 13 means any person engaged in the business of selling tickets of
- 14 admission or any other evidence of right of entry to a theater,
- 15 place of amusement or entertainment, or other place where public
- 16 exhibitions, games, contests, or performances are held, at a
- 17 price greater than the price printed on the ticket."

- 1 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
