## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DENTAL HEALTH.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that inadequate dental
- 2 care is a serious matter and has been identified as a major
- 3 health concern for low-income adults and children, individuals
- 4 with developmental disabilities, and the uninsured. These
- 5 individuals continually face great challenges in obtaining
- 6 dental care services in an appropriate and timely manner, and
- 7 the legislature finds this situation to be unacceptable.
- 8 The legislature further finds that federally-qualified
- 9 health centers are the most appropriate and efficient entities
- 10 in which to establish community-based dental clinics that will
- 11 provide a continuum of dental care based on best practices for
- 12 OUEST-eligible adults and children, individuals with
- 13 developmental disabilities, and the uninsured.
- 14 The purpose of this Act is to improve the State's ability
- 15 to address this dental health crisis by appropriating funds to
- 16 the department of health for the establishment or expansion of
- 17 community-based dental health clinics operated by federally-
- 18 qualified health centers to serve this population.

- 1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 and the
- 4 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 5 2008-2009 to establish or expand community-based dental health
- 6 clinics operated by federally-qualified health centers to
- 7 provide a continuum of dental care to QUEST-eligible adults and
- 8 children, individuals with developmental disabilities, and the
- 9 uninsured.
- 10 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 11 of health for the purposes of this Act.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
