A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GASOLINE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that gasoline that meets
- 2 the ethanol content requirement set forth in section 486J-10,
- 3 Hawaii Revised Statutes, is damaging to the non-metal parts of
- 4 the fuel storage and engine systems in marine engines and other
- 5 small gasoline-driven tools.
- 6 The purpose of this Act is to require refiners to make
- 7 available gasoline that does not contain ethanol for marine
- 8 equipment and small tool users.
- 9 SECTION 2. Chapter 486H, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 10 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 11 and to read as follows:
- 12 "S486H- Provision of gasoline not containing ethanol.
- 13 Each refiner, as that term is defined in section 486J-1, shall
- 14 make available to marine fueling stations and its company-
- 15 operated stations that are owned and operated by the refiner
- 16 gasoline that does not contain the ethanol content required by
- 17 section 486J-10."
- 18 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
