
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO CONDUCT A
FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR THE REPAIR AND REPAVING OF SIDE
STREETS ALONG KALIHI STREET.

1 WHEREAS, in recent years, the poor condition of Honolulu's
2 streets has been widely criticized; and

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4 WHEREAS, streets have fallen into a state of disrepair,
5 thereby causing anguish to drivers and sometimes causing damage
6 to their vehicles; and

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8 WHEREAS, while the City and County of Honolulu (C&C) has
9 taken great strides to clear the backlog of much-needed street
10 repairs and repaving, some areas are still in need of remedial
11 attention; and

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13 WHEREAS, one of these areas is Kalihi, where numerous side
14 streets are in need of repair and repaving; now, therefore,

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16 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
17 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
18 Session of 2007, the Senate concurring, that C&C is requested to
19 conduct a feasibility study for the repair and repaving of side
20 streets along Kalihi Street; and

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22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the study focuses specifically
23 on Kilohana Street, Waialele Street, Ahihi Street, Murphy Street,
24 Merkle Street, Noe Street, Laulani Street, Pahulu Street, Wahine
25 Place, Anuu Place, Manaiki Place, Akone Place, Mahani Loop,
26 Kuikele Street, Papali Place, and Kapali Street; and

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28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City and County of Honolulu
29 is requested to submit a report of its findings and
30 recommendations to the Legislature no later than 20 days prior
31 to the convening of the Regular Session of 2008; and



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1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this
2 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor of the City
3 and County of Honolulu.
