
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO ENACT H.R. 1287 AND S. 671 RELATING TO FILIPINO FAMILY REUNIFICATION, OR SIMILAR LEGISLATION, TO PROVIDE PRIORITY ISSUANCE OF VISAS TO FILIPINO VETERANS' CHILDREN WITH APPROVED IMMIGRATION PETITIONS.

1 WHEREAS, on July 26, 1941, President Franklin D. Roosevelt
2 issued Military Order No. 81, placing the Philippine
3 Commonwealth Armed Forces and the Special Philippine Scouts
4 under the United States Armed Forces command to join the
5 military assault against the Japanese forces in defense of
6 America's democracy; and
7

8 WHEREAS, throughout 1941-1946, tens of thousands of
9 Filipino soldiers were held as prisoners, risking their lives
10 and the lives of their families while maintaining underground
11 battles against the invading Japanese forces and boldly
12 assisting the United States Armed Forces in its campaign to
13 liberate the Philippines; and

15 WHEREAS, Filipino wartime veterans, many of whom were
16 permanently disabled and honorably discharged from the military
17 after serving more than ninety days on active duty military
18 service during World War II, are eligible for federal veterans
19 benefits and services; and

21 WHEREAS, former President Bill Clinton on October 17, 1996,
22 President George W. Bush on July 26, 2001, and the United States
23 Congress by H.R. 622 and S. 387 on September 13, 2006,
24 recognized and proclaimed the vital role that the Filipino
25 wartime soldiers played in assisting the United States Armed
26 Forces in defeating the invading Japanese forces in defense of
27 freedom; and

1 WHEREAS, through the Immigration Act of 1990, U.S.
 2 citizenship was awarded to each veteran but excluded the
 3 veterans' dependents, unfairly requiring that each veteran
 4 submit an immigrant petition with supporting affidavits
 5 requesting that the veterans' dependents be permitted to live
 6 with the veteran; and

7
 8 WHEREAS, the Legislature believes that upon the death of
 9 the veteran, death benefits should be transferred to the
 10 beneficiary of record, as indicated in the immigration petition,
 11 and the beneficiary should be exempted from the immigration law
 12 which attempts to nullify the immigration petition upon the
 13 death of the veteran; now, therefore,

14
 15 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
 16 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
 17 Session of 2007, the Senate concurring, that the United States
 18 Congress and United States President George W. Bush are
 19 respectfully requested and urged to enact H.R. 1287 and S. 671
 20 relating to Filipino family reunification, or similar
 21 legislation, to grant priority issuance of visas to Filipino
 22 veterans' children with approved immigration petitions; and

 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
 25 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the President of the
 26 United States, the Secretary of Defense, the Majority and
 27 Minority Leaders of the United States Senate, the Speaker and
 28 Minority Leader of the United States House of Representatives,
 29 and members of Hawaii's congressional delegation.
