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## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTING AND GENERAL SERVICES STUDY AND EVALUATE ALTERNATIVES IN UPGRADING THE STATE'S PAYROLL AND PERSONNEL SYSTEMS.

1           WHEREAS, the State's payroll system has not been upgraded  
2 in almost two decades; and

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4           WHEREAS, in some state departments the payroll is still  
5 done manually, and available technological improvements have not  
6 been implemented; and

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8           WHEREAS, the number of non-value-added activities creates  
9 lag time and impedes the ability of the Department of Accounting  
10 and General Services (DAGS) and line departments to deliver  
11 quality payroll services to employees in an efficient manner;  
12 and

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14           WHEREAS, some employees have waited months for step  
15 movements and for payments for mileage reimbursements, overtime,  
16 and unused vacation to be processed; and

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18           WHEREAS, the State's current payroll and human resources  
19 systems do not adequately meet the needs of government in the  
20 21<sup>st</sup> century; and

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22           WHEREAS, the State has an obligation to make changes to  
23 improve the technology used to issue payments, streamline  
24 government operations, enhance functionality, and eliminate a  
25 reliance on manual, paper-based processes through web-based  
26 services; now, therefore,

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28           BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
29 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular  
30 Session of 2007, the Senate concurring, that the Department of  
31 Accounting and General Services is requested to study and




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1 evaluate how its payroll system can deliver better, more  
2 efficient services to line departments and state employees; and  
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4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that DAGS is requested to submit a  
5 report of its findings and recommendations to the Legislature no  
6 later than 20 days prior to the convening of the Regular Session  
7 of 2008; and  
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9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
10 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor and  
11 Comptroller.
