
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS TO DEVELOP A
LONG-RANGE, COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR THE FUTURE OF KALAUPAPA.

1 WHEREAS, pursuant to section 203(3) of the Hawaiian Homes
2 Commission Act of 1920, Kalaupapa on the island of Molokai,
3 comprising five thousand acres, more or less, is designated
4 "available lands"; and

5
6 WHEREAS, pursuant to section 204 of the Hawaiian Homes
7 Commission Act of 1920, available lands "shall immediately
8 assume the status of Hawaiian home lands and be under the
9 control" of the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands; and

10
11 WHEREAS, pursuant to section 326-34, Hawaii Revised
12 Statutes, Kalaupapa is under the jurisdiction and control of the
13 Department of Health and is used for the care and treatment of
14 persons afflicted with Hansen's disease; and

15
16 WHEREAS, within the foreseeable future, Kalaupapa will no
17 longer be required for the care and treatment of persons
18 afflicted with Hansen's disease, at which time Kalaupapa should
19 retain its status as available lands and revert to the control
20 of the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands; and

22 WHEREAS, there is no long-range comprehensive plan relating
23 to the future of Kalaupapa; now, therefore,

25 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
26 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
27 Session of 2007, the Senate concurring, that the Department of
28 Hawaiian Home Lands is requested to immediately begin the
29 process of developing a long-range, comprehensive plan for the
30 overall future use of Kalaupapa; and

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Hawaiian Home
2 Lands is requested to work in conjunction with the National Park
3 Service, Department of Health, and Ka Ohana O Kalaupapa in
4 developing a long-range, comprehensive plan for Kalaupapa; and

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Hawaiian Home
7 Lands is requested to address the following in this long-range
8 comprehensive plan:
9

- 10 (1) Goals, objectives, and policies for malama aina of
11 Kalaupapa;
- 12
- 13 (2) Determination of the sustainable capacity for human
14 activity at Kalaupapa;
- 15
- 16 (3) Proposed land uses, including classifications,
17 criteria, and standards for the different types of
18 development;
- 19
- 20 (4) Protection and management of the rich prehistoric,
21 historic, and cultural resources of Kalaupapa;
- 22
- 23 (5) Protection and management of the flora and fauna,
24 including avifauna and marine fauna, in and around
25 Kalaupapa; and
- 26
- 27 (6) Protection of the aesthetics and natural beauty of
28 Kalaupapa;
- 29

30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Hawaiian Home
31 Lands is requested to submit an interim report to the
32 Legislature, at least twenty days prior to the convening of the
33 Regular Session of 2008, on the development of the long-range,
34 comprehensive plan for the future of Kalaupapa; and

36 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Hawaiian Home
37 Lands is requested to submit the completed long-range,
38 comprehensive plan for the future of Kalaupapa to the
39 Legislature, at least twenty days prior to the convening of the
40 Regular Session of 2011; and

42 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this
43 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the



1 Hawaiian Homes Commission, the Director of Health, and the
2 Pacific Area Director of the National Park Service.
