### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 346-53, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows: 3 "(c) The director, pursuant to chapter 91, shall determine 4 the rate of payment for domiciliary care, including care 5 provided in licensed developmental disabilities domiciliary homes, community care foster family homes, and certified adult 6 foster homes, to be provided to recipients who are eligible 7 [either] for Federal Supplementary Security Income  $[\tau]$  or public 8 9 assistance [in accordance with state standards], or both. 10 director shall provide for level of care payment as follows: For [those] adult residential care homes classified as 11 (1) 12 facility type I, licensed developmental disabilities 13 domiciliary homes as defined under section 321-15.9, community care foster family homes as defined under 14 section 346-331, and certified adult foster homes as 15 16 defined under section 321-11.2, the state supplemental 17 payment shall not exceed [\$621.90; and] \$641.90;
