A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO A GRANT TO KAHUKU HOSPITAL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
- 2 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 3 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.
- 4 SECTION 2. The legislature finds that it is in the public
- 5 interest to keep Kahuku Hospital operating in order to serve the
- 6 residents of the north shore of Oahu by enabling it to file for
- 7 chapter 11 reorganization bankruptcy, rather than for chapter 7
- 8 liquidation bankruptcy, which would allow the hospital to:
- 9 continue operations; preserve its hospital license; retain its
- 10 certificate of need and critical access hospital designation;
- 11 reorganize; and settle its debts. The board of directors of
- 12 Kahuku Hospital has agreed to continue the hospital's operations
- 13 into the first half of 2007 under a chapter 11 reorganization
- 14 proceeding pending the enactment of legislation that will have
- 15 the effect of causing Kahuku Hospital to be acquired by Hawaii
- 16 health systems corporation, or otherwise to become affiliated
- 17 with the Hawaii health systems corporation.

- 1 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate \$950,000 as a
- 2 grant, pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to
- 3 Kahuku Hospital on Oahu for fiscal year 2006-2007. The grant
- 4 will permit Kahuku Hospital to maintain operations, to cover the
- 5 costs associated with the chapter 11 reorganization and the
- 6 potential transfer of hospital operations to the Hawaii health
- 7 systems corporation.
- 8 The legislature finds and declares that this Act is in the
- 9 public interest and for the public health, safety, and general
- 10 welfare.
- 11 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$950,000, or so much
- 13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, as a
- 14 grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to
- 15 Kahuku Hospital on Oahu to continue its operations; preserve its
- 16 hospital license; retain its certificate of need and critical
- 17 access hospital designation; reorganize; and settle its debts.
- 18 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 19 health.
- 20 SECTION 4. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 21 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and sections 37-91 and
- 22 37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined

- 1 that the general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2006-
- 2007 (established at \$5,357,987,705 on November 8, 2006) has 2
- already been exceeded by \$90,137,694 or 1.68 per cent. The 3
- appropriations contained in this Act will cause the state 4
- 5 general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2006-2007 to be
- exceeded by an additional \$950,000, or an additional 0.018 per 6
- 7 cent. The calculation contained in the foregoing sentence
- relates only to the amount of general funds appropriated in this 8
- Ų Act for fiscal year 2006-2007. The reasons for exceeding the
- deneral fund expenditure ceiling are that the appropriations 10
- made in this Act are necessary to serve the public interest and 11
- 12 to meet the needs provided for by this Act.
- SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 13
