A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOLIDAYS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 "S8- Peace day. September 21 of each year shall be
- 5 known and recognized as "Peace Day" to promote peace programs,
- 6 improve international relations, and increase educational
- 7 awareness of peace; provided that this day is not and shall not
- 8 be construed to be a state holiday. All citizens shall be
- 9 encouraged to observe and celebrate the blessings of peace and
- 10 endeavor to create peace on peace day."
- 11 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
