A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PETROLEUM-CONTAMINATED SOIL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 342H-4.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 repealed. 2 3 ["[\$342H 4.5] Transporting prohibited without permit. No person shall transport any petroleum contaminated soil, as 5 defined in section 3426 1, without a permit issued under section 342H 4; except that no permit shall be required for the 7 transport of petroleum contaminated soil to a soil remediation 8 site, as permitted by the department if the transporter provides written notification to the department at least forty eight 9 10 hours in advance of any proposed transportation of petroleum-11 contaminated soil and abides by any transportation guidelines 12 set by the department."] 13 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 14 and stricken. 15 16 17
