A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the establishment of
- 2 a revolving fund for the department of education's office of
- 3 Hawaii child nutrition program is necessary to account for the
- 4 receipts from the administrative fees charged to the recipient
- 5 agencies for the distribution of federal commodity foods.
- 6 The legislature further finds that the United States Department
- 7 of Agriculture Food and Nutrition Service, Western Region
- 8 Office, monitors and approves the administrative fees charged to
- 9 the recipient agencies. However, federal legislation does not
- 10 allow the department of education to expend federal moneys for
- 11 the operations of state contracted warehouses.
- 12 The purpose of this Act is to create a revolving fund for
- 13 the collection and disbursement of generated revenue to support
- 14 the administration and operation of the department of education
- 15 food distribution program.
- 16 SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 17 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 18 and to read as follows:

- 1 foods to the recipient agencies. Any moneys remaining in the
- 2 revolving fund in excess of \$2,000,000 at the end of each fiscal
- 3 year shall lapse to the credit of the general fund.
- 4 (e) The food distribution program revolving fund shall not
- 5 be used for:
- 6 (1) Consultant or personal services rendered;
- 7 (2) Travel expenses that may include conference
- 8 registration, per diem, or airfare costs; or
- 9 (3) The purchase of furniture, equipment, computer
- hardware, or office supplies."
- 11 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the food
- 12 distribution program revolving fund of the State of Hawaii the
- 13 sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary for
- 14 fiscal year 2007-2008, and the same sum, or so much thereof as
- 15 may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009, for the payment of
- 16 services provided by state contracted warehouses for the
- 17 distribution of federal commodity foods to recipient agencies
- 18 under the department of education food distribution program.
- 19 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 20 of education for the purposes of this Act.
- 21 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 22 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
