(a) [Any] All federal, state, [or] and county [election 4 held other than on the date of a regularly scheduled primary or 5 general election may ] elections shall be conducted by mail. 6 7 (b) The chief election officer shall determine whether a federal or state election, other than a regularly scheduled 8 primary or general election, may be conducted by mail or at 9 10 polling places. (c) The county clerk shall determine whether a county 11 election, held other than on the date of a regularly scheduled 12 primary or general election, may be conducted by mail or at 13 14 polling places. An election by mail in the county shall be
