A BILL FOR AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

10	SECTION 6. The sums appropriated for the respective
11	capital improvement projects set forth in section 4 shall be
12	expended by the department of land and natural resources, in the
13	case of item 1, the department of water of the county of Kauai,
14	in the case of items 2 to 6, and the county of Kauai, in the
15	case of item 7 for the purposes of this Act.
16	SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007;
17	provided that sections 4, 5, and 6 shall take effect on July 1,
18	2008.
