### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR SCOOTER AND MOPED HELMET USAGE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 63, Session Laws of Hawaii 2006, requires a 2 person under the age of eighteen to wear a safety helmet when operating a moped or riding as a passenger on a moped. 3 legislature finds that helmets should be required to be worn by 4 5 all persons while operating or riding as a passenger on a moped, or while operating or riding as a passenger on a motor scooter, 6 7 regardless of age. The same safety and policy issues pertain to a motor scooter, which is only slightly more powerful, as to a 8 9 moped. 10 The purpose of this Act is to require all persons to wear a 11 helmet while operating or riding as a passenger on a moped, or 12 while operating or riding as a passenger on a motor scooter. 13 SECTION 2. Section 286-81, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 14 amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows: 15 "(a) No person shall: 16 (1) Operate a motorcycle or motor scooter, on any highway

- 3 SECTION 3. Section 291C-195, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 4 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 5 "(a) No person less than fifteen years of age shall drive
- 6 a moped on a highway, street, roadway, or any other public
- 7 property in the state. No person [less than eighteen years of
- 8 age] shall drive a moped unless the person wears a safety helmet
- 9 securely fastened with a chin strap. The safety helmet shall
- 10 meet the specifications and requirements established by rules
- 11 adopted by the director."
- 12 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
