A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a viable agriculture
- 2 industry requires a steady, reliable supply of water. However,
- 3 drought conditions continue to adversely affect our farms and
- 4 ranches, hampering our ability to produce quality products on a
- 5 consistent basis throughout the year.
- 6 The legislature believes that to address the negative
- 7 impact of droughts, mitigation measures laid out in the Hawaii
- 8 drought plan must be implemented. The goal of the Hawaii
- 9 drought plan is to develop coordinated emergency response
- 10 mechanisms, while at the same time outlining steps toward
- 11 mitigating the effects of future drought occurrences. The
- 12 Hawaii drought plan provides clear policies and specifies
- 13 response entities to implement immediate, short- and long-term
- 14 response measures to mitigate the impact of droughts.
- 15 The legislature also finds that in 2004, county drought
- 16 committees were formed for each of the four counties in Hawaii.
- 17 Each of the county drought committees developed a drought
- 18 mitigation strategy for their respective counties, with a focus

- 1 on drought mitigation projects. These county drought mitigation
- 2 strategies represent local needs and concerns of each county and
- 3 are incorporated by reference into the Hawaii drought plan.
- 4 The legislature further finds that to adequately implement
- 5 the Hawaii drought plan, sufficient funding to the counties is
- 6 necessary to address the many challenges that our agriculture
- 7 industry faces in preparing for droughts.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to provide funding to pursue
- 9 drought mitigation projects and measures in each county of the
- 10 state.
- 11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$4,000,000 or so much
- 13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 for
- 14 drought mitigation projects and measures in each county of the
- 15 state.
- 16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 17 land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
