SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS AND THE CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION FROM THE STATE OF HAWAII TO USE ALL THEIR EFFORTS, ENERGIES, AND ABILITIES TO WITHDRAW THE UNITED STATES FROM ANY FURTHER PARTICIPATION IN THE SECURITY AND PROSPERITY PARTNERSHIP OF NORTH AMERICA, AND WITHDRAW FROM AND AVOID PARTICIPATION IN ANY OTHER BILATERAL OR MULTILATERAL ACTIVITY THAT SEEKS TO ADVANCE, AUTHORIZE, FUND, OR IN ANY WAY PROMOTE CONTINENTAL INTEGRATION OR THE CREATION OF A "NORTH AMERICAN UNION".

1 WHEREAS, President George W. Bush, along with his Canadian
2 and Mexican counterparts, established the Security and
3 Prosperity Partnership of North America on March 23, 2005; and
4

5 WHEREAS, the stated goals of the Security and Prosperity
6 Partnership of North America are to address the threat of
7 terrorism and to enhance security, competitiveness, and quality
8 of life in the United States, Canada, and Mexico; and
9

10 WHEREAS, concern has been raised as to whether the Security
11 and Prosperity Partnership of North America is a step toward
12 continental integration or a "North American Union"; and
13

14 WHEREAS, concern has been expressed as to whether the
15 Security and Prosperity Partnership of North America will lead
16 to the erosion of United States sovereignty; and

18 WHEREAS, the Security and Prosperity Partnership of North
19 America is a White House prerogative that has not been presented
20 to the United States Congress as a trade agreement or treaty and
21 is subject to virtually no congressional oversight; now,


24 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fourth
25 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2007,
26 that the United States Congress, and specifically the
27 Congressional delegation from the State of Hawaii, are requested
28 to use all their efforts, energies, and abilities to withdraw
29 the United States from any further participation in the Security



1 and Prosperity Partnership of North America and withdraw from,
2 and avoid participation in, any other bilateral or multilateral
3 activity, however named, that seeks to advance, authorize, fund,
4 or in any way promote continental integration or the creation of
5 a "North American Union"; and

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
8 Resolution be transmitted to the President of the United States,
9 Majority Leader of the United States Senate, Speaker of the
10 United States House of Representatives, members of Hawaii's
11 Congressional delegation, and the Governor.
