Your Committees have amended this bill by:

- (1) Requiring an economic impact assessment on the effects of this measure in the 2010, 2011, and 2012 regular sessions;
- (2) Repealing this measure on July 1, 2013; and
- (3) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.
