Sir and Madam:

Your Committee on Conference on the disagreeing vote of the House of Representatives to the amendments proposed by the Senate in H.B. No. 1605, H.D. 1, S.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO TRAFFIC CONTROL,"

having met, and after full and free discussion, has agreed to recommend and does recommend to the respective Houses the final passage of this bill in an amended form.

The purpose of this bill is to enhance traffic flow on the island of Maui by appropriating funds for the development and implementation of an Intelligent Transportation System architectural plan for Maui, which includes a Maui traffic control center.

Traffic congestion continues to be a problem for the people of Maui. Traffic delays continue to intensify, creating slow transit times for commuters as well as public safety issues. Intelligent Transportation Systems apply communications and information technology to resolve traffic control issues and reduce congestion. The establishment of an Intelligent Transportation System on the



island of Maui, including a Maui traffic control center, would help to maximize traffic flow and alleviate traffic congestion.

Your Committee on Conference has amended this measure by:

- (1) Specifying that \$400,000 shall be appropriated from the State Highway Fund for the development and implementation of an Intelligent Transportation System architectural plan for Maui; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.





