Sir:

Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 863  
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO PUBLIC WORK PROJECTS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to ensure that private  
construction contracts where more than half of the project will be  
used by the State or a county, will comply with the prevailing  
wage law by requiring:

- (1) The project owner to certify that the project will  
comply with the prevailing wage law;
- (2) The certification to be filed with the Department of  
Labor and Industrial Relations (DLIR) and Department of  
Accounting and General Services; and
- (3) The project owner to submit certified payrolls weekly to  
the governmental agency that will be using the project.

The Hawaii Carpenters Union testified in support of this  
bill. DLIR opposed this measure. The County of Hawaii Office of  
Housing and Community Development provided comments.



Your Committee has amended this bill by making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity and style.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Finance that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 863, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Third Reading in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 863, H.D. 1.
