Your Committee on Energy & Environmental Protection, to which
was referred H.B. No. 869 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A STUDY ON
ENERGY EFFICIENT TRANSPORTATION STRATEGIES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to appropriate funds to the
University of Hawaii to conduct a study on energy efficient
transportation strategies in conjunction with the Department of
Business, Economic Development, and Tourism.

Your Committee received testimony in support of the measure
from the Department of Business, Economic Development, and
Tourism.

Your Committee finds that the study to be financed under this
measure will provide useful information toward achieving the
State's energy policies as articulated in the Hawaii State
Planning Act. Specifically, these policies relate to energy
dependability, efficiency, and economy as well as energy self-
sufficiency, energy security, and the control of greenhouse gas
emissions.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Energy & Environmental Protection that is attached to
this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and
purpose of H.B. No. 869 and recommends that it pass Second Reading
and be referred to the Committee on Higher Education.
