Your Committee on Transportation, to which was referred H.C.R. No. 340 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AND TOURISM, TO CONDUCT A STUDY TO EVALUATE PLANS BY YOUNG BROTHERS, LTD., TO DISCONTINUE ITS LESS-THAN-CONTAINER-LOAD INTERISLAND CARGO SERVICE, "

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to ensure the efficient and effective movement of cargo throughout Hawaii by requesting the Department of Transportation (DOT), in collaboration with the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism, to conduct a study to evaluate plans by Young Brothers, Ltd., to discontinue its less-than-container-load inter-island cargo service.

DOT, the Agribusiness Development Corporation, The Hawaii Business League, and L & R Farms Ent LLC, testified in support of this measure. The Division of Consumer Advocacy of the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs and Young Brothers, Limited, testified in support of the intent of this measure.

Hawaii's harbors serve as a lifeline between the major Hawaiian islands. Young Brothers, Limited, provides a valuable service to many businesses in Hawaii by shipping goods between the islands. "Less-than-container-load" service allows smaller

businesses to ship their goods between islands. The discontinuation of this type of service will have severe impacts on Hawaii's businesses, especially small businesses.
