Your Committees on Tourism & Culture and Economic Development & Business Concerns, to which was referred H.R. No. 153, H.D. 1, entitled:

"HOUSE RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION AND INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION TO CONVENE A JOINT HEARING WITH THE PARTICIPATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND PERMITTING OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO CONSIDER THE LIKELY IMPACTS ON TRAFFIC BY THE PROPOSED TURTLE BAY RESORT EXPANSION AND MITIGATIVE MEASURES THAT MAY BE REQUIRED BY THE EXPANSION,"

The purpose of this resolution is to address traffic concerns in the North Shore by requesting the Senate Committee on Transportation and International Affairs and House Committee on Transportation to convene a joint hearing, with the participation of the Department of Transportation and the Department of Planning and Permitting of the City and County of Honolulu, to consider the likely impacts on traffic by the proposed Turtle Bay Resort expansion and measures to mitigate traffic congestion that may be required by this expansion.

Keep the North Shore Country, Kuli'ou'ou/Kalani Iki Neighborhood Board #2, and a concerned individual supported this measure. Kuilima Resort Company (KRC) opposed this measure.

Your Committees find that a joint hearing will provide a public forum where traffic concerns relating to the expansion project may be addressed.

No. 153, H.D. 1, and recommend that it be referred to the Committee on Legislative Management.
