GRANT BACCALAUREATE DEGREES,"


begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this resolution is to request the University
of Hawaii (UH) to provide financial assistance to students from
Pacific Island jurisdictions that have historical ties to the U.S.
but do not have public higher educational institutions that grant
baccalaureate degrees.

The Hawaii County Council District 6 Councilmember and five
concerned individuals submitted testimony in support of this
resolution. The UH submitted testimony in opposition of this
measure.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Higher Education that is attached to this report,
your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.R. No. 196
and recommends that it be referred to the Committee on Finance.


