Your Committee on Education, to which was referred H.R. No. 35 entitled:

"HOUSE RESOLUTION URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF INTEGRATING PEACE EDUCATION INTO THE SCHOOL CURRICULUM,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this resolution is to urge the Department of Education (DOE) to study the feasibility of integrating peace education into the school curriculum.

A teacher from Pacific Buddhist Academy and students of Pacific Buddhist Academy, Honoka'a High School, Kalanianaole Intermediate School, Paauilo Elementary and Intermediate School, and Laupahoehoe Elementary and High School testified in support of this measure.

Based on the students' testimonies, it is the intent of this committee to have the feasibility study conducted with the DOE Civic Responsibility Working Group, Hawaii State Student Council and Student Conference Committee, Pacific Buddhist Academy, Service Learning Coordinator at DOE, and the Service Learning Impact Office at the University of Hawaii at Manoa.

Also, for clarification, components of peace curriculum should include civic responsibility, service learning, leadership skills development, and content dispositions, skills and applications. Furthermore, school curriculum should include

content in subjects and disciplines, as well as integrated activities, both curricular and co-curricular.
