Your Committees on Human Services and Public Housing and  
Intergovernmental and Military Affairs, to which was referred  
S.C.R. No. 23 entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING EACH COUNTY TO  
EXAMINE ITS CURRENT ZONING LAWS, BUILDING CODES, AND  
SUBDIVISION REQUIREMENTS AND ELIMINATE ENCUMBRANCES TO FAMILY  
CAREGIVING AND AGING IN PLACE,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to request each county to  
examine its current zoning laws, building codes, and subdivision  
requirements and eliminate encumbrances to family caregiving and  
aging in place.


AARP Hawaii submitted testimony in support of this measure.

Your Committees find that in 2000, individuals age sixty and  
older represented seventeen per cent of Hawaii's total population.  
It is estimated that this group will represent twenty-five per  
cent of Hawaii's total population by the year 2020. The vast  
majority of Hawaii's older residents prefer to age in place in  
lieu of costly institutionalized care elsewhere. Local  
communities must be prepared to accommodate the aging population  
and support their ability to age in place in their homes and  
communities. This measure requests the counties to examine their  
current zoning laws, building codes, and subdivision requirements  
so that encumbrances to family caregiving and aging in place can  
be eliminated.



As affirmed by the records of votes of the members of your Committees on Human Services and Public Housing and Intergovernmental and Military Affairs that are attached to this report, your Committees concur with the intent and purpose of S.C.R. No. 23 and recommend its adoption.
