HB 774

RELATING TO CEMETERY AUTHORITIES.

CPC

Requires pre-need trusts and perpetual care funds to distribute summaries of their audited financial statements to their purchasers.

HB 815

RELATING TO CEMETERY AND FUNERAL TRUSTS.

CPC

Establishes requirements for cancellation, refund, and default of prepaid funeral plan contracts. Clarifies requirements for prepaid

funeral plan contract terms.

HB 934

RELATING TO CEMETERIES.

CPC, WLH

Requires a cemetery authority to file with the department of commerce and consumer affairs a map of the cemetery, and a unique locating identifier that becomes a part of the contract disclosure requirements. Makes authority's books subject to examination by the department of

commerce and consumer affairs.

HB 92

RELATING TO THE GENERAL EXCISE TAX.

CPC, FIN

Requires an investment broker and agent who share compensation for their services to pay the general excise tax on only that portion of the

compensation retained by each. Effective 7/1/07.

HB 273

RELATING TO ANNUITIES.

CPC, FIN

Establishes standards and procedures to be followed by insurers or insurance producers when making recommendations to consumers who

are considering the purchase or exchange of any annuity.

HB 272	RELATING TO CAPTIVE INSURANCE COMPANIES. Allows captive insurance companies to be formed as limited liability companies. Clarifies minimum capital and surplus requirements. Increases investment flexibility for pure captives.	CPC
HB 1323	RELATING TO CAPTIVE INSURANCE. Establishes a \$200,000 maximum annual premium tax paid by captive insurance companies licensed by the DCCA.	CPC, FIN
HB 521	RELATING TO THE HAWAII HURRICANE RELIEF FUND. Authorizes the use of the Hawaii Hurricane Relief Fund to finance natural disaster reinsurance and catastrophe bonds.	CPC, FIN
