SB 1060 SD1. HD1 (HSCR1251) RELATING TO WORKERS' COMPENSATION LAW.

Amends workers' compensation law, including limiting an employer's ability to terminate benefits, authorizing the recovery of attorney's fees and costs by the injured employee, specifying procedures for medical examinations by the employer's physician, establishing fines for violations, requiring the reporting of denials of claims and relevant information, and further restricting the director of labor and industrial

relations' rulemaking authority. (SB1060 HD1)

SB 12 SD2, HD1 (HSCR1261) RELATING TO HEALTH INSURANCE RATE REGULATION.

Prohibits health insurance rates that are excessive, inadequate or unfairly discriminatory. Requires health care insurers to submit rate filings for approval by the insurance commissioner. Establishes

penalties and appeal procedures. (SB12 HD1)

SB 53 (HSCR1226) RELATING TO MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPISTS.

Includes marriage and family therapy among the mental illness and alcohol and drug dependence benefits required within the hospital and medical coverage offered under accident and sickness insurance

policies and similar insurance products.

SB 600 (HSCR1222) RELATING TO LEASEHOLD CONVERSION.
