RELATING TO APPRAISALS OF RESOURCE VALUE LANDS. Establishes procedures for the appraisal of resource value lands.

HB 1433 (HSCR146) RELATING TO MILITARY INSTALLATIONS.

Requires notification to the commanding officer of a military

installation of zoning change applications and district boundary amendment petitions for land within 3,000 feet or 2 miles(depending

HB 832 (HSCR634) RELATING TO HOUSING.

Requires the land survey division of the department of accounting and general services to establish the boundaries of the Del Monte employee housing at its Kunia camp comprising of approximately 50 acres of

TMK: 1st Div: 9-2-005:002. Makes an appropriation to purchase the housing area for eventual resale to former Del Monte employees and

retirees presently inhabiting the housing.

HB 1072 HDI (HSCR636)

RELATING TO HOUSING.

WLH/HSH, FIN

Establishes the Kakaako affordable housing development program and the Kakaako affordable housing development fund to provide incentives to developers building or rehabilitating affordable housing units in Kakaako over the next 5 years. Appropriates funds. Repealed 6/30/12.
