HB 652 HD1 (HSCR585)	RELATING TO DAM SAFETY. Creates dam safety special fund; creates dam rehabilitation loan program.	WLH, FIN
HB 507 HD2 (HSCR478)	RELATING TO BOATING. Prohibits the transfer of the State's small boat harbors to a county without legislative approval.	WLH, LMG, FIN
HB 1516 HD1 (HSCR554)	MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR IMPROVEMENTS AT AND THE RELOCATION OF HONOLULU MARINE, INC. TO KEEHI SMALL BOAT HARBOR. Makes an appropriation to make improvements at Keehi small boat harbor for the relocation of Honolulu Marine, Inc. from Kewalo basin.	WLH, FIN
HB 250 HD1 (HSCR587)	RELATING TO ALOHA TOWER DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION. Allows the aloha tower development corporation to undertake projects for commercial harbors under the jurisdiction of department of transportation.	WLH/TRN, FIN
HB 1590 HD2 (HSCR564)	RELATING TO EMINENT DOMAIN. Authorizes plaintiff to offer to resell property to defendant for current appraised value or condemnation price plus cost of environmental remediation or cleanup or other improvements if property taken in eminent domain is not used for the purpose for which it was condemned for five years. HB 1667 HD1 (HSCR678)	AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF REVENUE BONDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF LAND TO DEVELOP KALAELOA COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT. Authorizes the issuance of revenue bonds in the amount of \$ for the acquisition of land within the Barbers Point Naval Air Station by the Hawaii community development authority to develop the Kalaeloa Community Development District. <p>HB 402 HD1 (HSCR547)</p>	<p>RELATING TO THE LAND CONSERVATION FUND. Allows the Land Conservation Fund to acquire interests or rights in land having value as a resource to the State through agricultural easements. Specifies that the Land Conservation Fund can be used for the payment of debt service relating to the acquisition of interests or rights in land having value as a resource to the State.</p>	<p>WLH/AGR, FIN</p>
<p>HB 1442 (HSCR539)</p>	<p>RELATING TO KIKALA-KEOKEA. Authorizes the Department of Land and Natural Resources, subject to specific criteria and priority requirements, to award the remaining leases in the Kikala-Keokea area not previously executed under Act 314, Session Laws of Hawaii 1991.</p>	<p>WLH, FIN</p>
<p>HB 844 (HSCR583)</p>	<p>MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURCHASE OF REAL PROPERTY IN WAHIAWA, OAHU. Makes an appropriation for the purchase of land in Wahiawa, Oahu, underlying Lake Wilson or in the event of grant of the land by the landowners, an appropriation to maintain the Wahiawa dam.</p>	<p>WLH, FIN</p>
<p>HB 1899 HD1 (HSCR679)</p>	<p>RELATING TO KAWAI NUI MARSH. Requires the City and County of Honolulu to transfer to the State a parcel of pristine wetlands known as Kawai Nui Marsh, effective September 1, 2007. Also transfers other parcels of Kawai Nui Marsh to the State.</p>	<p>WLH, FIN</p>


DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW
