Clarifies that the reduced general excise tax rate of 0.5 per cent on business-to-business services applies to dealers furnishing goods or

services to the purchaser of tangible personal property to fulfill a

warranty obligation of the manufacturer of the property.

Provides a tax credit to high technology businesses that train high

school students in a cooperative education program.

HB 871 (HSCR438)	RELATING TO SEAWATER AIR CONDITIONING DISTRICT COOLING SYSTEMS. Allows the sale of cooling from seawater air conditioning district cooling systems to qualify for state enterprise zone benefits.	EEP/EDB, FIN
HB 1719 HD1 (HSCR179)	RELATING TO GENERAL EXCISE TAX. HB 570 HD1 (HSCR122)	RELATING TO GENERAL EXCISE TAX. Exempts from the general excise tax amounts received by the operator of the Hawaii convention center for reimbursement of costs or advances made pursuant to contract with the Hawaii tourism authority.	TAC, FIN
