Appropriates funds for the design of a Maui traffic control center.

HB 1447 HD1 RELATING TO NOISE.

TRN, JUD, FIN

(HSCR563)

Establishes a noise abatement zone for motor vehicles and mopeds and

assesses an escalating fine starting at \$100 and impoundment of

vehicles for transgressors. Effective date of July 1, 2051.

RELATING TO COUNTY SURCHARGE ON STATE GENERAL

(HSCR299) EXCISE TAX.

Reduces annual reimbursement by city and county of Honolulu to the State from gross proceeds of the county's surcharge on the general excise tax from 10% to 5% or \$5,000,000, whichever is less.

HB 70 HD2 (HSCR686) RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

TRN, EDB, FIN

Allows the State to enter into agreements with private entities to build, operate, own, or finance transportation facilities including toll

highways.
