SB 796 SD2, HD1 (HSCR1485) RELATING TO CIVIL DEFENSE.

Requires the counties to condition the approval of permits for the construction of new residential housing in tsunami inundation zones on the installation of tsunami warning sirens. Authorizes the governor to release and expend up to ten per cent of the interest earned on funds in the emergency and budget reserve fund to provide grants of emergency assistance for uninsured damages after a natural disaster. Requires the

disability communications access board to identify internationally recognized symbols to be used in the event of a disaster or emergency to communicate to persons that do not understand verbal or written

communications.

Allows national guard personnel on state active duty to deposit their paycheck by electronic transfer to their personal banking accounts.

RELATING TO INCARCERATED PARENTS.

Appropriates funds for the expansion of incarcerated parent-child interaction programs, such as the Strengthening Keiki of Incarcerated Parents Project, at state correctional facilities and institutions servicing

other offender populations.
