Establishes a process to determine the most appropriate means of memorializing the World War II Japanese internment camp experience in Hawaii. Appropriates funds to the department of land and natural

resources.

Community College for a Music and Enterprise Learning Experience Program and a music and entertainment business training center at

Honolulu Community College.

SB 1283 SD2, HD1 (HSCR1431) RELATING TO THE HAWAII TOBACCO SETTLEMENT

SPECIAL FUND.

Allows University of Hawaii to use its allotment of moneys from the Hawaii tobacco settlement special fund to pay for operating expenses of the new medical school facility in addition to paying debt service.

SB 1154 SD2, HD1 (HSCR1483) RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

HED, FIN

Provides more flexibility to the University of Hawaii in the financing and administering of the construction and maintenance of university projects, university systems, or networks.
