SB 907 SD2, HD1 (HSCR1409) RELATING TO AEROSPACE DEVELOPMENT.

EDB, FIN

Renames the Office of Space Industry, the Office of Aerospace Development, and adds additional duties relating to identifying and promoting opportunities for expanding and diversifying aerospace-

related industries in the state. Appropriates funds.

SB 896 SD1, HD1 (HSCR1407) RELATING TO HIGH TECHNOLOGY.

EDB/WLH, FIN

Appropriates an unspecified amount in FY 2007-2008 and FY 2008-2009 to the High Technology Development Corporation to negotiate a ten-year lease to house a technology incubator and

innovation center in a life sciences research complex in Kakaako and for planning, development, and operational costs of the center.

Requires an annual progress report to the Legislature.

SB 1315 SD2, HD1 (HSCR1410) RELATING TO THE ACCESS HAWAII COMMITTEE.

EDB, FIN

Codifies sections of Act 292, Session Laws of Hawaii 2000, to make the Access Hawaii Committee, which provides oversight of the internet portal manager, permanent. Adds a representative of the Legislature's

data management system and the Administrative Director of the

Judiciary to the committee.

SB 1365 SD2, HD2 (HSCR1405) RELATING TO THE INNOVATION ECONOMY.

EDB/HED, LAB,

Requires the Employees' Retirement System to consider the allocation of funds for Hawaii venture capital investments, unless it is not prudent to do so; appropriates funds to the University of Hawaii Office of

Technology Transfer and Economic Development to enter into a partnership with a private sector entity. Effective July 1, 2050.

SB 795 SD2, HD1 (HSCR1375) RELATING TO BUILDING CODES.

CPC, FIN

Creates a State Building Code Council. Establishes state building code

and design standards. Appropriates funds.

SB 1008

RELATING TO ANNUITIES.

CPC, FIN

SD1, HD1 (HSCR1280) Enacts a new part in insurance code to provide for sales and solicitations of annuities.
