Appropriates funds to implement a new human resource management model for Waianae complex, including Waianae High School and its feeder schools to improve teacher recruitment and licensing.

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.
Authorizes the agribusiness development corporation to issue revenue bonds to purchase agricultural land in Kunia and Ewa from private entities. Appropriates funds to purchase the lands. Enables the agribusiness development corporation to contract with banks to provide lease management services. Allows corporation to lease agricultural lands in Kunia and Ewa for up to 55 years.


DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW
