RELATING TO EDUCATION.

Appropriates funds to implement a new human resource management

model for Waianae complex, including Waianae High School and its feeder schools to improve teacher recruitment and licensing.

SB 837

SD2, HD1 (HSCR1352) RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

Authorizes the agribusiness development corporation to issue revenue bonds to purchase agricultural land in Kunia and Ewa from private

entities. Appropriates funds to purchase the lands. Enables the agribusiness development corporation to contract with banks to provide lease management services. Allows corporation to lease

Appropriates funds to the University of Hawaii to establish a global

youth center in Hawaii.

SB 1182

SD2 (HSCR1345) RELATING TO NEEDS ALLOWANCE.

Establishes a needs allowance for residents of care homes and long-

term care facilities.
