| S.B. 1101 | RELATING TO CHILDREN<br>Establishes a task force to coordinate resources for homeless children, establishes and appropriates funds to a special fund; sunset date.  | HSP, WAM |
| S.B. 1162 | RELATING TO CHILD WELFARE<br>Provides notice of permanent plan hearings to a child who has reached the age of 14.   | HSP, JDL |
| S.B. 1163 | RELATING TO FOSTER CHILDREN'S TRANSITION TO ADULTHOOD<br>Mandates State to provide independent living programs to foster children at age 14.  | HSP, WAM |
| S.B. 1164 | RELATING TO CHILDREN<br>Establishes guiding principles for foster children.   | HSP, JDL |
| S.B. 1166 | RELATING TO CHILD PASSENGER SAFETY<br>Appropriates funds to educate the public about the child passenger restraints law and to help subsidize the cost of child booster car seats for low-income families.  | HSP, WAM |
| S.B. 1167 | RELATING TO CHILD CARE<br>Allows certain qualifying recipients of public assistance to provide full-time, at-home child care to children two years of age or less, and to receive a percentage of the child care subsidy the State would otherwise pay for the child care services. | HSP, WAM |
| S.B. 1170 | RELATING TO CHILDREN<br>Appropriates funds for the healthy start program, including enhanced healthy start, hiring of additional staff, and training.   | HSP, WAM |
| S.B. 1173 | RELATING TO PERINATAL CARE<br>Appropriates funds to continue the pilot perinatal clinic for women with a history of substance abuse on Oahu.  | HSP, WAM |

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| S.B. 1114 | RELATING TO MEDICAID<br>Requires the department of human services to directly reimburse sellers of over-the-counter Plan B emergency contraception to women who are recipients of Medicaid, without incurring expenses for recipients, who purchase such medications. Appropriations. | HSP, WAM |
| S.B. 1120 | RELATING TO STATE EMPLOYEE CHILD CARE FACILITIES AND SERVICES<br>Requires the State to provide state employees with child care facilities and services. Permits State to charge for cost of child care.   | HSP, WAM |
