Allows assisted living facilities with twenty-four hour staff,

individualized evacuation plans, and sprinkler and fire door systems to accept individuals with an impairment that prevents the resident from

safely evacuating with minimal assistance.

RELATING TO EXCISE TAX ON HEALTH CARE.

Exempts physician services, hospital charges, nursing services, and rehabilitation services from the county surcharge on state tax.

Appropriates \$2,000,000 to the department of health to assess the structural integrity of all hospitals and nursing homes in Hawaii to determine their ability to withstand different types of natural disasters.

RELATING TO COUNTIES.

HTH/IGM

Allows counties to enact ordinances to permit the use of motorcycles operated by emergency rescue workers to respond to emergency rescue calls, in addition to any other type of vehicle that is otherwise deemed

appropriate as a response vehicle by each county.

Decision Making to follow, if time permits.
