SB 236	RELATING TO CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES. Makes pseudoephedrine a schedule V controlled substance requiring a prescription.	HTH, JDL
SB 257	RELATING TO CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES. Prohibits pre-signed and predated prescriptions. Clarifies how the narcotic enforcement division administrator shall conduct inspections at pharmacies.	HTH, JDL
SB 811	RELATING TO PRESCRIPTION DRUGS. Makes rebate agreements between drug manufacturers and department of human services mandatory. Requires the department to inform health care providers about drug costs for manufacturers with rebate agreements and those without rebate agreements.	НТН, СРН
