HB 316

RELATING TO WORKERS' COMPENSATION.

LAB, FIN

Excludes services performed by an individual who is a member of a limited liability company or a partner of a limited liability partnership who has a distributional interest in the company or partnership of at least fifty percent, a partner of a partnership, and a sole proprietor from the definition of "employment" under the workers' compensation law.

The following bills were heard on February 6, 2007 agenda.

HB 1082

RELATING TO BOARDS OF WATER SUPPLY.

LAB, FIN

Repeals the provision encouraging experimental modernization projects by county boards of water supply.

HB 1146

RELATING TO REHIRING OF GOVERNMENT RETIREES.

LAB, FIN

Authorizes the State and the counties to rehire government retirees and allow retirees to collect pension benefits while working.

HB 1162

RELATING TO THE REHIRING OF RETIREES.

LAB, FIN

Authorizes the State and the counties to rehire governmental retirees under civil service procedures and without additional pension benefits.

HB 1660

RELATING TO THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

LAB, FIN

Makes adjustments to the Employees' Retirement System.

HB 1818

RELATING TO GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES.

LAB, FIN

Permits state and county governments to rehire retired employees as permanent employees without affecting the rehired retirees' retirement

benefits.

HB 1819

RELATING TO THE REHIRING OF RETIREES.

LAB, FIN

Authorizes state and county governments to rehire retired employees during labor shortages and for difficult-to-fill occupational areas

without retirement benefit penalty.
