DECISION MAKING ON THE FOLLOWING MEASURE(S):

SB 932	RELATING TO A COMPREHENSIVE OFFENDER REENTRY SYSTEM. Establishes offender reentry system to assist adult and juvenile offenders with preparing for release and reintegration back to the community. Establishes interagency committee and appropriates funds for demonstration projects	PBS, WAM
SB 855	RELATING TO CORRECTIONS. Appropriates funds to the department of public safety to provide a cognitive restructuring and transition program in the county of Hawaii.	PBS, WAM
SB 672	RELATING TO INMATE REINTEGRATION PROGRAMS. Appropriates funds for a grant to Maui Economic Opportunities, Inc., for the administration of community-based reintegration programs to reduce the return of former immates to prison by providing training and support services for successful transitions into the community.	PBS, WAM
SB 912	RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY. Appropriates funds for the expansion of the restorative circles pilot program to other correctional facilities statewide.	PBS, WAM
SB 910	RELATING TO CORRECTIONS. Establishes a one-year pilot day reporting center administered by the department of public safety. Appropriates funds.	PBS, WAM
SB 1174	RELATING TO INCARCERATED PARENTS. Appropriates funds for the expansion of incarcerated parent-child interaction programs, such as the Strengthening Keiki of Incarcerated Parents Project, at state correctional facilities.	PBS, WAM
SB 919	RELATING TO CORRECTIONS. Requires the mainland branch of the corrections division to monitor and report on the condition of Hawaii resident inmates housed in	PBS, WAM

mainland prisons under the interstate correction compact.

SB 917 RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY. PBS, WAM Appropriates funds to the department of public safety to develop a plan by January 1, 2008, to return all female Hawaii prisoners incarcerated in mainland prisons back to Oahu by July 1, 2009. SB 911 RELATING TO PRISONS. PBS, WAM Requires the Department of Public Safety to conduct a study to identify three sites within the State for a new minimum security prison by December 15, 2007. Requires a report to the Legislature by January 1, 2008. SB 916 RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY. PBS, WAM Requires a feasibility review regarding the sale of the Oahu community correctional center in order to build a new facility in a different location to accommodate and manage the continued growth of the inmate population. SB 913 RELATING TO PAROLE. PBS, WAM Authorizes the Hawaii paroling authority to parole committed persons to any county in the State where they will receive the greatest support to successfully reintegrate into the community.
