Recodifies and renames existing motion picture, digital media, and film production tax provisions; increases the tax credits from fifteen and twenty per cent to twenty and twenty-five per cent; increases reporting requirements; repeals the Hawaii television and film development board; deletes references to the board from the Hawaii television and film development special fund and elsewhere. RELATING TO TRANSIENT ACCOMMODATIONS TAX.

TAC/EDB, FIN

Requires department of taxation to: review the forms and process for collecting the transient accommodations tax from vacation rentals and bed and breakfast establishments and report revenues received from them; work with Hawaii tourism authority and counties to identify owners operating vacation rentals and bed and breakfast establishments and enforce transient accommodations tax compliance; share location information on transient accommodations taxpayers with counties.

Clarifies duties of Hawaii tourism authority. (SD3)
