RELATING TO TOURISM

TSG

Requires that Hawaii Visitors and Convention Bureau board members wait at least two years after that directorship has expired before serving

on the Hawaii tourism authority's board of directors.

SB 601

RELATING TO CONTRACTS

TSG

Authorizes contractors and subcontractors to include in their subcontracts additional provisions that must be met before the subcontractor is entitled to receive final payment for completion of

work on a government project.

SB 866

RELATING TO HOLIDAYS

TSG

Establishes September 21 of each year as Peace Day to promote peace programs, improve international relations, and increase educational awareness of peace. Encourages citizens to observe and celebrate the blessings of peace and endeavor to create peace on the holiday
