WLH/AGR

Imposes conditions on the subdivision of lands in the agricultural district. Limits county zoning power in agricultural district. Requires special permit for land in rural district to require approval of land use

commission.

WLH/AGR

- (1) Sets forth permissible uses on important agricultural lands;
- (2) Requires counties to adopt by ordinance permissible uses and infrastructure standards within rural and urban districts; and
- (3) Makes comprehensive amendments to land use law to improve use of rural and agricultural lands.

#### RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL LANDS.

WLH/AGR

Expedites the designation of important agricultural lands by the land use commission by eliminating the landowner/farmer process and the county process, and allowing the land use commission to initiate the designation process and allowing landowners to petition the land use commission for designation. Allows the landowner petition for important agricultural land designation to take effect without the legislative enactment of incentive/protection legislation. Removes the

county from the special permit process.

HB 1037

RELATING TO COASTAL ZONE MANAGEMENT.

WLH

Extends shoreline setback to not less than 150 feet and not more than

200 feet.
