HB 240

RELATING TO SMALL BOATING FACILITIES.

WLH, FIN

Requires that at least % of the funds in the Boating Special Fund be used for costs of maintenance and repair of existing small boat harbor improvements, and % of the funds be used for principal and interest

for capital improvements.

HB 258

RELATING TO COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT.

WLH, FIN

Establishes the Ala Wai community development district. Provides development objectives and guidelines. Provides for request for proposals for the private redevelopment and operation of Ala Wai boat harbor. Transfers Ala Wai boat harbor from department of land and natural resources to Hawaii community development authority.

HB 960

RELATING TO SMALL BOAT HARBORS.

WLH, FIN

Authorizes the Board of Land and Natural Resources to designate a small boat harbor improvement project if it determines that there is need for replanning, renewal, or redevelopment of the facilities and

infrastructure. Provides a means for financing.

HB 1387

RELATING TO DERELICT VESSELS.

WLH, JUD

Clarifies DLNR's jurisdictional responsibility on the removal of

derelict vessels.

HB 1849

RELATING TO BOATING.

WLH, FIN

Increases mooring fees by 50% on 01/01/08, and by an additional 10%

each subsequent 01/01 over the next 4 years.

HB 1914

RELATING TO BOATING.

WLH, FIN

Prohibits a person from mooring a boat at a state small boat harbor unless the person has obtained sufficient insurance to cover boat

removal costs should the boat run aground.
